School Uniform

The following items may be worn all year round:

Jacket or Jumper

- Navy polar fleece jumper with school logo
- Navy fleecy windcheater or hoodie with school logo
- Navy Soft Shell Jacket with school logo

Polo shirts

Navy or Gold long and short sleeved with school logo.

Dress

Blue and white check dress (in Winter can be worn with navy blue tights/stockings/leggings).

Bottoms

- Plain, navy blue track pants, leggings or pants without decoration or brand name
- Plain navy skorts without decoration or brand name (in Winter can be worn with navy blue tights/stockings/leggings).
- Plain, navy blue shorts (mid-thigh length) without decorations or brand name.

Socks or tights/stockings

- Navy blue or white socks
- Navy blue tights/stockings

Footwear

- Appropriate footwear is to be worn. It should be practical and functional for school use and the activities timetabled on that day.
- Black or brown school shoes, pull on school boots or runners are permitted.
- No thongs, slides or open-toed sandals are permitted.

Winter Clothing (Optional Items)

- Navy Blue coat
- Navy blue "beanie" in winter -school logo
- Navy blue or yellow scarf

Hat

Navy broadbrim hat with logo

Hair/Make Up

- Hair longer than shoulder length needs to be tied back.
- Navy blue or gold head bands, hair ribbons, "scrunchies" or headwear worn as part of cultural/religious beliefs. Elastic Bands used to tie up hair may be worn in any colour.
- No form of makeup or nail polish is to be worn to school

Jewellery

For safety the following are only permitted:

- Studs or small sleepers in ear lobes
- Watch, I.D tags, medical tags
- No visible facial piercings.

Exemptions:

Regulations state that parents may apply for exemption from the school dress code under the following categories:

- Religious grounds
- Cultural grounds

- Children with disabilities
- Health grounds
